

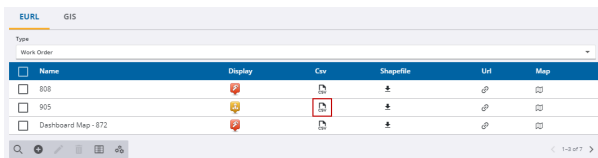
Share an eURL Query

Queries enable you to share maps created through inspection, request, work order, and case queries, also known as searches. This application generates a URL (web address) that can be used to show an event layer on another map outside of Trimble Unity, such as ArcGIS Online (AGOL) and ArcGIS Enterprise (Portal).

Licensed users for eURL can share searches with others. Open the **eURL Configuration** page and share by using one of the following methods:

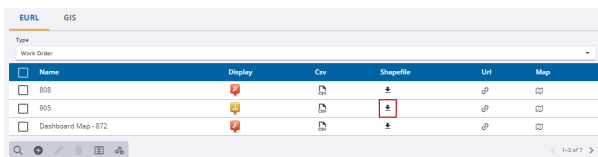
By CSV File

1. On the **eURL** tab, select the **Type** from the drop-down list.
2. Click the **Csv** icon next to the eURL query you would like to share. This generates a zipped .csv file containing the saved query data. Latitude and longitude fields are also included in this file.



By Shapefile

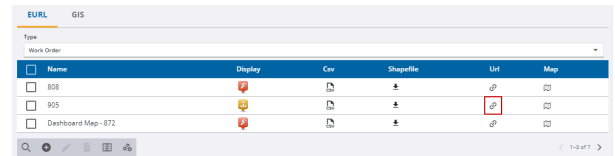
1. On the **eURL** tab, select the **Type** from the drop-down list.
2. Click the **Shapefile** icon next to the eURL query you would like to share. This generates a zipped shapefile. The data is projected to Lat and Long when it is added to the shapefile.



By URL Link

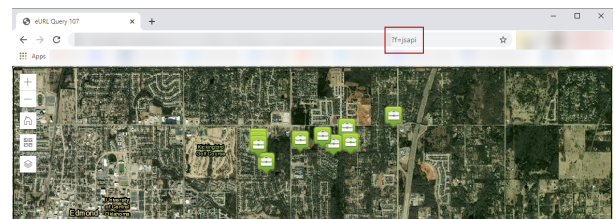
1. On the **eURL** tab, select the **Type** from the drop-down list.

2. Click the **Url** icon next to the eURL query you would like to share. A new browser tab opens that contains a service URL that can be shared.



IMPORTANT: The **URL** option uses the domain-level map that is defined for public use in Admin under **GIS > GIS Services**.

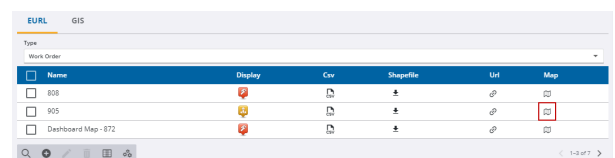
3. Enter **?f=jsapi** at the very end of the URL and press **Enter**. A map appears with the query displayed.



4. Send the **URL** link to others, add an event layer, or add it to another map outside of Trimble Unity (i.e., ArcGIS Online).

View on Map

1. On the **eURL** tab, select the **Type** from the drop-down list.
2. Click the **Map** icon.



The map opens in a new browser tab.
