

## Add a Third-party Widget

You can add a widget to a plugin on specific layouts either through a widget slot or directly to a layout. A widget slot is a container or "area" (for a specific layout) that has been enabled (by a Cityworks developer) where a widget can be added. These widgets allow you to integrate with third parties.

 Select a plugin to customize, such as Respond.


To add a widget to an enabled widget slot, complete the following:

- 2. Select the page from the **Layout** drop-down list in the **Profile** panel.
- 3. Select the widget slot you want to add a widget to.
- 4. Click Add Widget.



To add a widget to a specific layout:

- Select the page from the Layout drop-down list in the Profile panel.
- Select a control in the Controls panel.
- Click Insert Widget.
- Select the widget and click Configure Widget.



The Widget Configurator panel opens.

- 5. Select the Widget Type: HTML or Link.
- 6. Enter the **Widget Name**. This is what the users will see in the plugin.
- 7. Click the information icon for instructions and an example of adding a link widget.
- Click the settings icon to change the theme for the editor.



- 9. Enter the code in the **Typescript** field. You can copy and paste the example code from the information icon, but don't forget to change the code (i.e., URL or Type (icon) to what you need).
- 10. Use the **CSS** field to style your **Typescript** code.

NOTE: Intellisense is available in the Typescript and CSS fields and allows you to easily create and complete your code.

- 11. Click Save.
- 12. Click **Save Profile** on the **Profile** panel to save changes to the profile.
