Customize a Plugin

Plugins are customizable at a user level. This means that each layout associated with the plugin has controls that can be customized one way for one user and another way for a different user.

1. In the **Profile** panel, select the plugin from the **Plugin** drop-down list.

The version of the plugin installed in your site displays in the **Plugin Version** field.

2. Select the profile you want to make edits for in the **Profile** drop-down list. If you want a different profile than the default, you can create a profile.

BEST PRACTICE: It is best to not customize the default profile in case you need to revert back to the original plugin layouts when it was first installed.


3. Select the page you want to make edits for from the **Layout** drop-down list.

The **Layout** drop-down list varies depending on the plugin you are customizing.



If Respond has been selected as the **Plugin**, then the **Work Order Edit** page is available to select from the **Layout** drop-down list. However, if Storeroom is selected, you'll notice the **Work Order Edit** page is not available to select from the **Layout** drop-down list.

NOTE: If you have customized another layout in a different profile, you can import the layout to another profile. See Import a Layout in the Style Guide for Trimble Unity Maintain and Trimble Unity Permit for more information.
